

St Crispin's Special School

St Crispin's Special School is a new build construction which provides for over 70 children with autism and additional support needs.

The school includes a swimming pool and a specialist behavioural support unit that will support St Crispin's and other additional support needs schools from across the city. The new school is used as a community hub, providing facilities and accommodation after school hours and during holiday periods for families of children with special needs, partner agencies and charity groups.

The school is built with the flexibility to cater more for upper primary and secondary pupils if required and will also offer enhanced facilities for out of school and weekend activities.

Project Highlights

- The majority of the lighting is automated within the building and the system monitors presence detection and daylight levels
- All services in classrooms are carefully coordinated and collated together at teaching stations
- A full AV package has been provided including interactive whiteboards
